Find a picture of the first home you ever lived in. Consider adding information about when your family moved there, where you are, who was living there with you. If you don't have a picture, you might be able to find one by searching it out on GoogleMaps and screen capturing it.

Where was this picture taken and is there any other interesting information about where it was taken, what you're wearing, etc. What is your first memory? Do you remember anything else about being this age?

Learning new skills can be challenging and interesting. What do you remember about learning to ride a bike or to roller skate or to advance a talent? What was hard for you to learn? Tip: Remember, this is your story! Use the pictures you want to tell your story.

What do you remember about this vacation? Where did you go, how did you get there, and who was with? What was the most fun? What other interesting memories do you have of this vacation?

8	SIBLING PICTURE	Name each of your siblings as well as what age they were when the picture was taken. Where were you and what were all of you doing when the picture was taken?
9	FAMILY WORK PROJECT	Was your family big on family work projects? Did everybody have to help with yard work? Or perhaps there was a big project that made an impact in your family's life? You might also consider what chores you had to do on a certain day of the week or even every day? Talk about the who, what, when, and where of your family project.
10	PICTURE OF FAVORITE PET	Write your pet's story; What was it name and why? Why kind of pet was it and why did it get chosen? Why was this the favorite pet? Add any other details about the sights, sounds, and feels of your pet.
11	CRASH, BOOM, BANG	Do you have any stories about accidents or incidents or scars you've accumulated over the years? How did your accident/incident come about? Was this a learning experience? Was anyone else with you and where did it happen?
12	FAVORITE HALLOWEEN COSTUME PIC	Have an especially memorable Halloween costume? How old were you? Did someone make your costume? How old were you when you stopped trick or treating? Tip: Seriously, you're STILL trick or treating?
13	FAVORITE HOLIDAY PICTURE	Why is this holiday your favorite? What special preparations were made? Are there specific parts that are repeated every year? Do you know where this tradition originated?
14	MIDDLE SCHOOL ACTIVITY	Did you participate in sports, choir, theater, or other extracurricular activities in middle school? What were your interests and why? Any special moments or friends associated with these activities?
15	HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITY	What picture best reflects your interests in High School? Do you have your graduation picture? When and where did you graduate and what were you feeling that day? Tip: This could also be your "first ride" or first date or first girl/boy friend.
